



## Vaccinating

Our vaccines cover Distemper, Parvovirus, Leptospirosis, Infectious Hepatitis, Kennel Cough and Rabies.

Puppies (or older dogs restarting their vaccine course), should receive 2 vaccinations, 4 weeks apart. This is typically at 8 and 10 weeks old for puppies. Kennel Cough and Rabies can be administered according to individual circumstances and requirements.

Following on from the initial vaccine course, your dog will require a yearly booster. White Mill Veterinary Centre will notify you by post or text when this is due.

Most boarding kennels will require Kennel Cough and an up-to-date vaccination certificate before they allow your dog to stay.

If you plan to travel abroad with your dog, please speak to a member of staff, who will be able to advise you or specific requirements for your destination.
